The mother is responsible and accountable for her relationship with the Lord. In all this, however, she does not act alone but would undoubtedly travel with her husband to the sanctuary and bring her nursing baby with her. This would make a child's first encounter with the Lord the result of a mother's obedience to come before the Lord in worship.
